Reactions with alkalies (lyes).

PROTECTIVE MEASURES, RULES OF CONDUCT**Respiratory protection**

Breathing apparatus in the event of aerosol or mist formation.
Short term: filter apparatus, filter P3. (DIN EN 143)

**Hand protection**

0,7mm Butyl rubber, >480 min (EN 374).
The details concerned are recommendations. Please contact the glove supplier for further information.

Eye protection

Tightly fitting goggles. (EN 166:2001)

Skin protection

Protective clothing.

Hygiene measures

Do not eat, drink, smoke or take drugs at work.
Use barrier skin cream.
After worktime and before work breaks the affected skin areas must be thoroughly cleaned.
Take off contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.



Suitable extinguishing media	Product itself is non-combustible. Fire extinguishing method of surrounding areas must be considered.
Personal precautions, protective equipment and emergency procedures	Ensure adequate ventilation. High risk of slipping due to leakage/spillage of product. Use personal protective equipment (protective gloves, safety glasses, protective clothing).
Environmental precautions	Do not discharge into the drains/surface waters/groundwater. Prevent spread over a wide area (e.g. by containment or oil barriers).
Methods and material for containment and cleaning up	Pick up with absorbent material (e.g. sand, sawdust, universal absorbent, diatomaceous earth). Dispose of absorbed material in accordance within the regulations.
Special protective equipment for firefighters	Use self-contained breathing apparatus. Wear full protective suit.
Additional information	Fire residues and contaminated firefighting water must be disposed of in accordance within the local regulations.

FIRST AID MEASURES

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Description of first aid measures	Take off contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.
Inhalation	Remove the victim into fresh air and keep him calm. In the event of symptoms seek medical treatment.
Skin contact	In case of contact with skin wash off immediately with soap and water. Immediate medical treatment necessary, as untreated burns can result in slow-healing wounds.
Eye contact	Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. Consult a doctor immediately.
Ingestion	Consult a doctor immediately. Do not induce vomiting. Rinse out mouth and give plenty of water to drink.
